2. Non-Residential* Remodel (*includes mixed use)
3. Residential New Construction
4. Residential Remodel

SPECIAL AWARD CATEGORIES (for Citation Consideration):

5. Detail Category: Propose unique or extraordinary architectural details
6. Unbuilt Category: Submit projects fully designed but never realized
7. Historic Renovation/ Restoration: Present appropriate solutions in an historic context
8. Sustainable Strategies: Highlight a cutting-edge sustainable feature (Constructed)

\$75.00 Each entry

- Current AIAMB Members, AIAMB Associate Members, & AIA Affiliate Members (in good standing with the AIA for the last two years)
- Projects completed within the last 5 years (10 years for Special Unbuilt category)
- Project location can be anywhere for an AIAMB member & must be within the Chapter Tri-County service area for an Affiliate member.
- Previously submitted projects which did not win an award may be re-submitted
